Old Business

- Summary of player evaluation meeting:
 - Definitely need to be more consistent at evaluations and a more efficient, higher quality process -- Troy working on format
 - Make sure evaluation process is explained well at each evaluation session
 - Difference between the U9-U10 "evaluation and the U11 and older "tryout" : U9-U10 evaluations should remain skill based with small sided games, U11 and older should emphasize scrimmaging only
 - Final decision still with coaches and director
 - Still an issue to get enough volunteers
 - Do not think outside evaluators are necessary
 - Possible use of incentives for coaches to evaluate
 - Majority of coaches present at the meeting think that coaches should evaluate at their own age group, other than their own child
 - There was a split between those that thought a second night of evaluations for U11-U13 was necessary
 - Suggestion to set up coordinators at each age group
 - Suggestion (subsequent to the meeting) to run the U11 and U12 evaluation together
- Phil Bentz volunteered to check into use of a school facility for a winter indoor Futsal league for U6-U8, possibly expanding to older ages.

New Business

- Discussion on U13-U14 boy's teams and what will happen in the fall. Goal will be as usual to make sure everybody plays and to match player's ability to the team level as best as possible.
